

How do I get a test for coronavirus (COVID-19)?

Lincolnshire has Coronavirus testing available for all staff members and their household if they are symptomatic.

If you, or a member of your household, are displaying symptoms of Coronavirus then on **day 1 of these symptoms** contact your employer immediately as this will ensure that you get an appointment for testing if needed. If you miss day 1, please notify them as soon as possible as it may not be too late

The symptoms for Coronavirus are


- New continuous cough and/or
- High temperature

The below eligibility criteria applies to you as a staff member and any household members over 2 years of age:

- The person, or persons, in the household displaying symptoms of coronavirus, often referred to as the Index Case(s), should be tested
- The test should ideally occur between days 1 to 3 but testing can be done up to day 5.


After you have notified your employer, they will arrange testing for you, and you will be provided with information about where to go. Please **do not** visit any testing site without an appointment, as you will not be tested.







Scenario 2: Householder member (over 18) has symptoms
