Clinical research at ULHT has been put centre stage with the opening of a						
£205,000 new research facility at Pilgrim hospital.						
Clinical research in Lincolnshire's hospitals generate approximately £1.6						
million for the Trust every year.						
The new Lincolnshire Clinical Research Facility provides all of the  resources required to run comprehensive research studies and clinical						
resources required to run comprehensive research studies and clinical trials at the hospital, for the benefit of staff and patients.						
The number of clinical trials and studies carried has increased from 10 to						
nearly 200 over the last 10 years, with more than 2,000 patients involved a						
year.						
At Pilgrim, the research team is working on a number of trials including						
oncology, haematology, stroke, cardiology, paediatric, dermatology,						
diabetes, midwifery, ophthalmology, respiratory, anaesthesia,						
gastroenterology, renal and orthopaedics.
