This 3-day course is aimed at lower sixth students who are serious about wishing to pursue a career in medicine and who are also academically able to achieve the grades necessary to enter medical school. The current minimum A level grades needed are AAA, (Grade A in Biology and Chemistry is the norm plus a further A level at Grade A).		,	
Students will spend the 3 days based in the Undergraduate Medical Education Centre. They will have the opportunity to shadow a junior doctor, observe an operating theatre list, practice their interview technique and spend an afternoon with Lincoln GP registrars. Students will also have the opportunity to try their hand at some basic clinical skills such as suturing and cannulation using special manikins in our clinical skills lab.
