 Staff at ULHT have continued in their commitment to reduce avoidable pressure ulcers in our hospitals. PUNT (Pressure Ulcer Notification Tool), is our unique online system that allows staff to record, monitor, report and review reliable pressure ulcer data for hospital patients. The tool has also has attracted international interest from Californian based company Bruin Biometrics (BBI), a developer of innovative sensor-based diagnostic equipment. As a result of introducing PUNT, the Trust has reduced the incidence of pressure ulcers to as low as 0.9% compared with a national rate of between 4-6%.
