A member of the health team is usually available to answer questions and can weigh your baby in a separate place or after the group, if there is a medical or feeding need.

Specialist Midwife Infant Feeding Team

If you are having significant challenges with establishing breast/chest feeding or breast/chest milk production, you can ask your midwife for a referral to the Specialist Midwife Infant Feeding Team up until your baby is 28 days old.

The health visiting team has Infant feeding support workers, who may contact you to offer support, soon after your baby is born. In addition, you can ask your health visitor for a referral to a lactation clinics if you need specialist support or are having significant challenges with establishing breast/chest feeding or breast/chest milk production.
