Here are some Festive Fundraising Ideas to get you started

Christmas Jumper Day

Wrapping Party

If you're a group that enjoys wrapping, get together put on a Christmas movie and wrap together.

Last hour's pay

If you know your colleagues are not going to wear a Christmas jumper or get involved with another virtual quiz, you could ask them to donate their last hour of pay for the year – This may seem like a small donation, but can actually make a big difference. Simply pop a donation over to the charity for the amount.

Christmas Decorations

Keeping fundraising fun and legal!

Get permission if you want to host a collection.

Get in touch with us (charities.team@ulh.nhs.uk) if you'd like to hold a collection, there are some criteria that we will need to help you with all the guidelines for your collection tin.

If you're planning on holding a public collection, you'll need a license. For example, if you're collecting in the street you'll need to get in touch with your local council.

If you're collecting on or outside private property, such as a supermarket, you'll need to ask the manager and get the relevant materials from us.

Keep Safe

If your plan is to organise something in person, make sure that you continue to respect social distancing and wear face masks if possible. If you are unsure on anything, please do email us at charities.team@ulh.nhs.uk.

Auctions and Raffles

There are extremely strict laws relating to all lotteries and raffles so be sure that you are familiar with these and operate your auction or raffle accordingly. There may be circumstances when a license may be required. For information, please take a look at the Fundraising Regulator's web-site. You can also visit gamblingcommission.gov.uk for information.

Food and drink

If you plan to have food available or will be serving food at your fundraising activity, then you'll need to ensure it's safe. Check out the Food Standards Agency for guidelines on handling, preparing and storing food.

Handling money

Here are some tips for handling money:

- Be cautious when carrying money around.
- Make sure at least two people are around when money is being handled and counted.
- Collect cash using a secure container (provided by the charity).
- Get funds through to the charity as soon as possible.

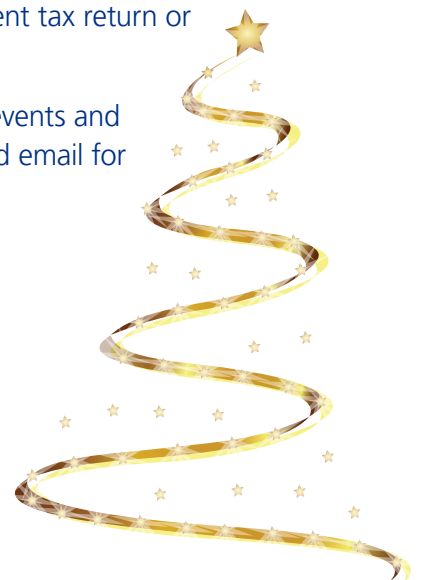

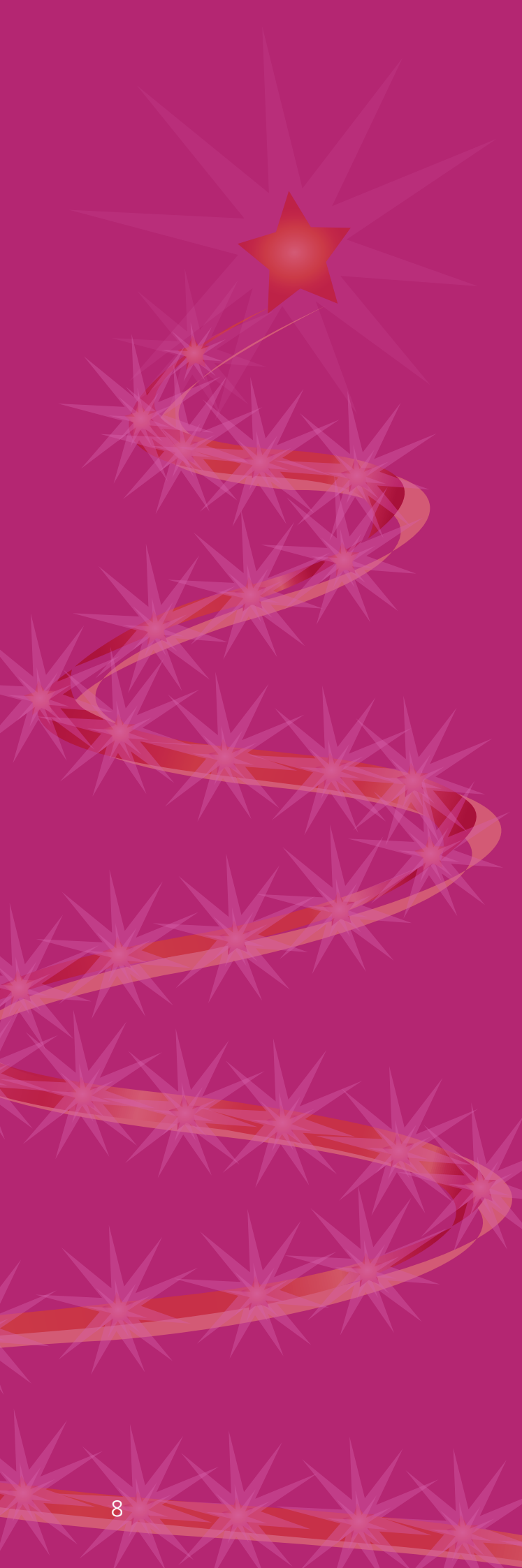
