The patient has not had a previous Sepsis Screen or a Sepsis Screen was completed > 6 hours ago – PRESS RECORD NOW AND SCREEN THE PATIENT FOR SEPSIS The patient's observations remain unchanged and there is no deterioration and they have had a negative sepsis screen within the last 6 hours – PRESS NOT REQUIRED (event notes can be used to explain the rationale) The patient has a Rising NEWS and/or Clinical Deterioration and/or Suspected Sepsis and they have had a negative sepsis screen within the last 6 hours—

PRESS RECORD NOW AND SCREEN THE PATIENT FOR SEPSIS

The patient has been screened and treated for Sepsis within the last 6 hours -PRESS NOT REQUIRED (event notes can be used to explain the rationale) If the patient has been treated for Sepsis and they are still NEWS ≥ 5 for > 6 hours they should have an urgent senior clinical review to consider both alternative diagnosis and the appropriateness of the treatment already given - PRESS RECORD NOW AND SCREEN THE PATIENT FOR SEPSIS
