Chapels and Prayer Rooms

Chapels and Prayer Rooms are available for quiet, prayer and reflection on each of the hospital sites. The hospital chapels have been dedicated for Christian worship, but they are for all who wish to use these areas for personal times of quiet, prayer and reflection. All Chapels and Prayer Rooms are accessible at all times of the day/night to all, regardless of any faith or belief.

Lincoln County Hospital

The chapel is located on Level 2 past main reception, at the end of the corridor on the left. The Multi-Faith Prayer Room is located on the same corridor as the Chapel in the Swanpool Suite, opposite ICU. Washing facilities, are available in the Prayer Room. Users of the room are encouraged to bring their own prayer mat for personal use or else disposable roll is available.
