Main Duties

Paediatric inpatient unit- Rainforest and Safari ward: clerking in patients, attending to needs of critically unwell children under senior supervision, carrying out simple paediatric procedures under supervision of senior colleagues and senior nurses (venipuncture, simple peripheral venous cannulations), simple communications with parents and patients with senior colleague backup and advice, understanding the basic practical principals of safeguarding children (Elaine Todd- ULHT safeguarding nurse), work towards safeguarding children under senior supervision and advice, prescribing (RCPCH e-learning module).

Attend ward rounds, post ward round work, attend and contribute in handover, liaison with colleagues for intra and interdepartmental patient care related communications, liaison with other hospitals regarding patient care, discharge planning- EDDs, participating in departmental clinical governance activities - audits and clinical projects (Dr Agarwal Audit Lead), understanding about risk management and IR1 reporting.

Neonatal unit: Attending neonatal unit and transitional care handover and ward rounds, requesting investigations, performing simple neonatal procedures (heel prick, peripheral cannula, capillary blood gas). Actively involved in baby checks – initially under senior supervision to get signed off.

On the Tier One rota, including 09:00-17:00 shifts on Rainforest, Safari, Nocton or Nettleham ward, out of hours shifts 17:00-21:00, weekends long days 09:00-21:00, night shifts 21:00-09:00.
