<p>General Adult Psychiatry, Lincolnshire Partnership Foundation NHS Trust Lincoln</p> <p>The post is based in the acute adult inpatient psychiatric unit based at the Peter Hodgkinson Centre in Lincoln.</p> <p>This post provides 5 days per week experience in acute general adult in-patient psychiatry, working on a busy 19 bedded male general adult acute inpatient ward (Ellis Ward). The ward averages over 300 acute admissions per year with an average length of stay between 20 and 40 days. The medical team comprises of two Consultant Psychiatrists, one Foundation 1 Trainee, one Foundation 2 Trainee, one CT1 Trainee and two GP Trainees.</p> <p>The F2 doctor would also have the opportunity to attend, and if appropriate present, at the weekly postgraduate programme during term time, which typically includes a Case Presentation, Presenting the Evidence (Journal Club) and a presentation by an external speaker.</p>
