<p>This post is based primarily in Theatres and will provide the learning of important anaesthetic skills such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General and regional anaesthesia • Basic and advanced airway management • Venous cannulation • Record-keeping • Pain management including nerve blocks and sedation and the pharmacology of anaesthetic agents. <p>The post holder will also participate in Pain & Critical Care Outreach rounds. There will be direct supervision by a consultant, SAS doctor or Senior Sister at all times.</p> <p>There will be the opportunity to learn the assessment and initial management of critically ill patients upon the surgical unit in theatres and in recovery.</p> <p>The post also includes opportunities to participate in audit and QIP projects.</p> <p>During the rotation the post holder will participate in the hospital's on-call rota. This will include weekdays, weekends and Hospital@Night rota providing ward cover for the medical and surgical wards out of hours. This post will offer valuable experience in the management of medical patients whilst on call under supervision.</p> <p>This experience will help to obtain competencies in the management of acutely unwell medical patients and also patients with long term medical conditions.</p> <p>The FY1s will be working under the supervision of the senior team.</p>
