<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Participate to Urology Ward rounds - Deliver any pending tasks(e.g EDS, scan requesting, e-referrals, medication prescribing etc) on inpatients under urology - Deliver tasks on urology patients, as picked up by the preassessment team(e.g, arrange investigations where needed, arrange prescription of medications) - Participate to urology educational events(audit meetings, teaching sessions), as detailed in the "Educational activities" box - Participate to other activities of the urology department, as detailed in "Comment box" - Participate to the surgical out of hours on call rotation - During 4 month rotation, on average, one week of nights split Mon-Thu, Fri-Sun, with rest days pre and post night shifts. This will be supporting Urology Acute on call with the ACP, clerking emergency admissions, generating differential diagnoses, initiating management plans, requesting investigations and interpreting results
