<b>Job Description</b>			
<p>This post provides 5 days in general adult psychiatry. The role of the F1 will be to do physical examinations and be a part of the MDT team in assessing and managing the patients. The F1 trainees will have opportunity to review patients individually and to present them at ward round discussions. They will also have opportunity to liaise with acute hospital medical team which is next door to department of psychiatry.</p> <p><b>General Adult Psychiatry, Ward 12, Pilgrim Hospital Boston</b> This is a busy 20 bedded mixed general adult acute in-patient ward. The medical team comprises of a full time Consultant Psychiatrist, one GP Trainee, one F2 and one additional F1. There is a Speciality doctor cover for attached crisis team. The crisis team is next door to acute ward, which will provide opportunity to shadow crisis team in the community. The ward prides itself on its multi-disciplinary team approach to patient care.</p> <p><b>The trainee would aim to complete the necessary e-portfolio requirements ie; CbDs, Mini-Cex etc during the posting.</b></p> <p><b>At the end of the posting the trainee would aim to gain enough experience to feel confident to be able to manage mental health cases and make provisional diagnosis.</b></p> <p><b>The trainee is expected to follow the Good Medical Practice guidelines as set by the GMC and follow the Trust information &amp; governance policies particularly regards record keeping and confidentiality.</b></p>
